Conference Details:

There will be an opening soirée on Friday, October 26 at the [Cedar Meadows Resort and Spa](#). All of the workshops and displays will take place at [Timmins High and Vocational School](#) on Saturday, October 27. All workshops will take place in classrooms which will be set up with student desks or tables and chairs. Wifi access and data projectors will be available in each room. Presenters should bring their own laptops; extra speakers and your presentations on USB keys are encouraged. The maximum number of people per session will be 30.



Presenter Remuneration:

As a workshop presenter*, you are eligible for the following remuneration:

Distance	Remuneration
Workshop presenters* who reside within 100km of Timmins	One complimentary conference registration Entrance to Friday's cocktail reception Saturday Breakfast Saturday Lunch
Workshop presenters* who reside 100+ km from Hamilton	One complimentary registration \$100 to cover expenses, such as hotel and mileage Entrance to Friday's cocktail reception Saturday Breakfast Saturday Lunch

*Please note that remuneration as a workshop presenter is only provided to elementary and secondary teachers (as well as retired teachers). When a session is sponsored by a post-secondary faculty member, an exhibitor, a publisher, a business, or any other for-profit organization, OMLTA/AOPLV does not provide reimbursement of any kind to these presenters. (These should be negotiated between the presenter and the university/exhibitor/publisher or business.)

If your workshop proposal is accepted, we will forward you a code to use to complete your registration, meal choices, and other relevant information.

Expenses can be claimed once per conference only, regardless of the number of sessions presented. In the case of a workshop with multiple presenters, the remuneration will be remitted to one person only on behalf of the OMLTA and should be shared. Breakfast and lunch will be provided to multiple presenters from one workshop.

As a presenter, you will need to make all accommodation and travel arrangements yourself. Pay expenses in advance and save your receipts (as appropriate). All receipts are then submitted at the conference to the treasurer on Saturday, October 27, 2018. The treasurer will review your expense request and reimburse accordingly. You will need to see the treasurer in the morning to hand in your receipts, and again at the end of the day to pick up your reimbursement (as appropriate).
